Dear friends,

I can't quite believe that I am now coming to the end of my third year as Children and Families Missioner at Ramsey and what a fun journey it has been so far! I hope you don't mind but I thought I would hijack this week's bulletin introduction to share some of the ways we are seeing and feeling growth in our church and what we are putting in place to guide our children in their faith journeys.

- We are delighted that we now have a larger number of families with children attending all of the services, with the greatest growth being in Holy Communion services.
- We are now very much a Family Church, which does mean that there will be noise at times, and we appreciate your support with making our families with young children feel welcome.
- We have made the decision to increase our Sunday Fun session to twice a month and we have been heartened that we have had four new volunteers approach us to help with this and toddler provision.
- We are in the process of setting up a toddler safe area in choir vestry, with soft furnishing, new carpeting and spiritual resources for little ones.
- Naomi and Charlotte have offered to lead a toddler input on the same days as Sunday Fun in the choir vestry.
- Now more children aged 7 and above are taking Holy Communion, we have been working on teaching what taking the bread means. Maggie came into 3in1 club this week and demonstrated with one of the children copying alongside with a small version of the chalice etc. It was such a special moment! Over the next few weeks I will be setting up a small altar in the chill-out area with a box of resources for children to use as they learn about Holy Communion.

- We are looking forward to our next holiday club on 27-29th August where we will be learning about what it means to be 'Children of God'. We can't wait!
- Look out for more information coming soon about provision for youth at St Thomas a Becket. Maggie, Joe and I have a few things in the pipeline that we are excited about!

Thank you so much for the support you have given me since I have arrived at St Thomas a Becket. It's a very special community to be a part of.

Amazingly he manages to take all his personal belongings in carry on luggage ,saving the hold bag for our donated items. So our wish list is as follows:

- Single <u>flat</u> sheets and pillowcases any colour
- Children's shoes or trainers these can be second hand
- Boys school shorts (grey) aged 10-13
- Cottons and needles for the girls in the sewing training classes whose teacher we sponsor.
- Paint brushes
- Donations of £5-£10 to buy girls sweaters out there
