Dear friends,

This Sunday marks the start of Advent, the season of preparing for the coming of Jesus. With Christians around the world, we return to the story of the patriarchs, matriarchs and the prophets, who were waiting for God's promised Saviour, and we become more aware of our present time of waiting for the return of Jesus, who will one day bring all things into the light, ensure justice for all who have been oppressed and usher in a kingdom of everlasting peace on earth. This is good news in our world today, where so many feel hidden in darkness, are victims of injustice and are not living in situations of peace and safety. But it is also a warning, to any who would seek to cover things up, or oppress and exploit others, or threaten the peace and safety of another.

This is the prayer for the first Sunday of Advent which will be said as we light the Advent wreath in church on Sunday morning. There are five prayers, focusing each week in turn on the witness of the patriarchs/matriarchs, the prophets, John the Baptist, the virgin Mary and, on Christmas Day, Jesus himself. You might like to light a candle at home during the week and pray this prayer for the first week of Advent:

God of Abraham and Sarah, and all the patriarchs of old, you are our Father too. Your love is revealed to us in Jesus Christ, Son of God and Son of David. Help us in preparing to celebrate his birth to make our hearts ready for your Holy Spirit to make his home among us. We ask this through Jesus Christ, the light who is coming into the world. Amen.
