

## St Thomas à Becket, Ramsey e-Bulletin 7 June 2026



It's a busy time of year. At the time of writing, the fête is still to happen and we're looking anxiously at the weather forecast, wondering what shape it will take. If you read this online you will get it before the fête, if you get a paper version you may not read this until after the event.

Our hope is that the fête will give us an opportunity to draw the community in to us, to enjoy a social event to meet us, and spend some money to support the work our churches do (and the work of our stall holders). On the next few Sundays, we will offer hospitality with teas for the bands on the green.

Our reading on Sunday comes from Matthew chapter 9. This is a busy section in the middle of the gospel, among many miracles, we read of Jesus calling Matthew (the tax collector and gospel writer), then dining with those who were not welcomed by the Jewish religious leaders (aka sinners). Jesus then heals a ruler's daughter and a woman who had suffered from a haemorrhage (so probably "unclean") for 12 years. A thread through many of the healings, and the dinners with the tax collectors is that Jesus's ministry and teaching was not for a holy huddle in the synagogue, but for all people, those who the religious leaders ignored or looked down upon.

The fête and the band teas are times when we offer hospitality and fun to anyone in the community, and they are times when we raise funds to help with our work in the community.

If you have helped, or about to help with the fête, thank you for supporting our work. If you supported the fête by buying a piece of cake and a coffee, thank you.

**Adult baptisms and the renewal of baptism vows:** On Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June, as part of our 10:30 service, we are very excited to be offering a service of baptism for adults, as well as the opportunity to renew baptismal vows. Baptism is one of the central rites of the Church, it is how we publicly express our faith, and the conscious decision to turn our lives towards Christ. There is powerful symbolism in leaving our old selves in the water, and being raised with Christ to new life. For that reason we are hoping to have a small pool of some sort at the front of church.

If you **haven't** been baptised before, and would like to be baptised on this Sunday, we'd love to hear from you! There is a sign-up sheet at the back of church, or you can speak to Revd Joe.

If you **have** been baptised, perhaps as a child, and would like to renew your baptismal vows, we are also inviting people to do so in one of two ways:

1. Publicly alongside the adults being baptised, or
2. More subtly with the wider congregation.

I will be giving more information about how this will work practically on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> June. For now, we just need to know whether you would like to either be baptised, or to renew your baptismal vows. Please take some time to prayerfully consider whether this is for you now.
